



Volunteer Role: Enhanced Cultural Orientation (CO) and Mentorship Volunteer

Time Commitment: A minimum commitment of 2 hours a month, with the option to commit more hours depending on volunteer.

Requirements To Volunteering:

- Willingness to teach or lead a Cultural Orientation class or topic lesson
- Willingness to work with Limited English Proficient clients
- Willingness to help mentor newly arriving clients on basic Cultural Orientation topics
- Willingness to create new lessons or activities based around 15 topics of CO
- Willingness to work in groups
- Additional languages, always a plus, but not necessary

Role:

The Enhanced Cultural Orientation and Mentorship Volunteer will be responsible for helping the MVRCR AmeriCorps Enhanced Cultural Orientation staff member with developing needed lessons and educational materials for class sessions. Volunteers will also assist with field trips and teaching sessions around specific CO topics, as well as interpretation if possible. As mentorship for new arrivals as needed, they may provide more individualized approaches to the CO curriculum.
