



**Volunteer Role:** Refugee Health Assessment Transportation Volunteer

**Time Commitment:** A regular, weekly commitment comprised of either 3 days: Monday, Weds, Friday or 2 days: Tuesday and Thursday, or Monday through Friday. 8am until 1pm throughout the week and according to arrivals.

**Requirements To Volunteering:**

- Willingness to Provide Transportation to Clients
- Reliable Transportation
- Accountable and Punctual
- Clean Driving Record
- Must have Driver's License on file at MVRCR to use agency vehicles
- Willingness to be in contact with relevant MVRCR Staff
- Adherence to Strict Patient and Client Confidentiality
- Must have training on child passenger seats by appropriate MVRCR staff

**Role:**

The Refugee Health Assessment Transportation Volunteer will assist the MVRCR Resettlement Staff with the transportation logistics of required Refugee Health Assessments (RHA's) for newly arriving clients at various healthcare sites in the Utica area. The volunteer will be registered to drive agency vehicles and meet clients either at MVRCR or pick up at their residences prior to the scheduled RHA appointments and drop off and pick up clients as needed. Volunteers will be expected to confirm completed health screenings and also communicate with Resettlement Caseworkers any additional steps needed to be taken or any follow up appointments that are needed to be scheduled for the client. Basic training will be provided to the Volunteer.
