Fire Prevention Tips for Home

Drapes/Tapestries/Wall Hangings

- □ Hang away from stoves/ovens/heat sources.
- $\hfill\square$ Keep them away from candles and incense.
- □ Don't hang them over smoke detectors and light fixtures.

Candle, Incense, & Matches

- $\hfill\square$ Put candles or incense in sturdy fire-proof containers.
- $\hfill\square$ Blow out all candles before going to bed or leaving the room.
- $\hfill\square$ Never leave children and pets unattended with lit candles.
- $\hfill\square$ Put matches and lighters where children cannot reach them.

Smoking (Cigarettes, Hookah, Shisha, Pipes, etc.)

- □ Extinguish ashes in a large, deep ashtray or put hot ashes in water to extinguish.
- □ Empty extinguished ashes into a container that will not burn.
- $\hfill\square$ Never put burning tobacco into a waste baskets or garbage cans.

Heating

- Put furniture and other items that can catch fire at least
 3 feet from fireplaces, wall heaters, baseboards, and space heaters.
- $\hfill\square$ Do not use extension chords to plug in space heaters.
- □ Use heaters that are approved by a national testing laboratory and have a tip-over shut-off function, and never use them while sleeping.

Electrical & Appliances

- □ Always put surge protected power strips above rugs, never under them.
- $\hfill\square$ Do not use electrical cords that are worn-out or cracked.
- $\hfill\square$ Hire only certified electricians to work in your home.
- □ Only use surge protected power strips. Too many things plugged into extension cords cause fires.
