

Driving Without A License

- Traffic infractions, not crimes
- No knowledge requirement
- No right to free lawyer
- Can hire private lawyer
- Usually punished by money fine



Aggravated Unlicensed Operation

- A crime-either a misdemeanor or a felony
- Driving when you know your license is suspended or revoked
- Will be entitled to a free lawyer
- Can choose to hire your own lawyer
- Usually punished by significant money fines

Aggravated Unlicensed Operation

- Can also be punished by probation or jail time
- Failure to appear in court can result in bench warrant

Impaired Driving

- A traffic infraction-not a crime
- Driving while impaired due to consuming alcohol
- No right to free lawyer
- Can hire private lawyer
- Usually punishable by significant money fines
- Usually results in license suspension
- Usually results in mandated treatment



Intoxicated Driving

- A crime-either a misdemeanor or a felony
- Driving while intoxicated due to consuming alcohol or drugs
- Will be entitled to a free lawyer
- Can choose to hire your own lawyer
- Usually punishable by significant money fines
- Usually results in license suspension-right away
- Usually results in mandated treatment



Intoxicated Driving

- Can also be punished by probation or significant jail time
- Failure to appear in court can result in bench warrant
- Will be required to pay for and drive with an ignition interlock device
